"Enjoy an afternoon by the river Cam on the final day of the famous May Bumps Races. St. Catharine's pitch by the river provides excellent viewing across a stretch of the river which usually sees some exciting chases. Included with each of these tickets are two alcoholic drinks, unlimited teas/coffees, cakes, fruit and soft drinks. The pitch is open from 12.30 and you are welcome to bring your own picnic if you wish. Parking is adjacent to the riverside pitch.

Attached to this catalogue, you will find a rough (!) map of where the pitch is, as well as a document explaining Bumps in more detail. I always say - if you haven't seen it, you have to come and see it to believe it. Next year's races will take place during the week of 11th June and the final day will be Saturday, 16th June."

The Bumps are an historic form of racing between the college boat clubs, and run to a format dating back to the 1820s. It's a fantastically exciting one. Divisions of 17 or 18 crews line up along the river, with just one-and-a-half boat lengths (90 feet) between each. At the firing of a small cannon, all hell breaks loose as each crew tries to catch up with and actually collide with (bump) the crew in front before the crew behind does the same to them!
