We have been given the opportunity to trial the services of a landscaping firm, Hanging Gardens. There has been a case of chickenpox reported in Pre-Prep. A child remains infectious until all the spots have crusted over, and must be absent from school during this time. Chickenpox is highly contagious and the incubation period is ten to twenty-one days.
